1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Chagrin Lagoons Yacht Club is the organizing authority for the 2017 CLYC June JAM Regatta.

2 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The World Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 – 2020, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the PHRF-LE class rules, and the Sailing Instructions. The following prescriptions of the US Sailing will not apply: 60, 63.2 and 63.4.

RRS 63.7 is replaced by "If there is a conflict between The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions the Sailing Instructions shall apply."

RSS 60.1, 78.1 and 78.2 are also changed. See paragraph 8.

This regatta is classified as a Category C Event in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.

The Sailing instructions may change other rules.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all members of US Sailing, other National Governing Body, members of recognized yacht clubs, or members of recognized sailing associations.

Races will be offered only for JAM rated boats. The 2017 CLYC JAM Regatta is a Cleveland Sailing Association (CSA) counter for JAM Boat of The Year.

4 REGISTRATION

Registration for eligible boats is on line at <http://CLYCJuneJam.Ltstechnology.com>. Boats may also register either by mail or in person using the forms available on-line and at the CLYC office at the address shown above, (Monday through Friday, 9:00-4:00, 440-942-0299). Make checks payable to Chagrin Lagoons Yacht Club. Please mark all mail and checks to the attention of the CLYC sail fleet.

Completed forms, rating certificate, and appropriate fees must be received by the CLYC office no later than Wednesday, June 7, 2017. Signed waivers must be received no later than the start of the skippers meeting on Saturday.

Late entries will be accepted in hardcopy until 7:00 PM, Friday June 9, and will be subject to an additional fee as noted below.

The Organizing Authority reserves the right to limit the number of participants to that which can be safely accommodated.

5 FEES

The entry fee is \$50.00, payable by credit card or Paypal on line, and by check by mail or in person. An additional \$10 fee will be charged for late entries. A \$10.00 discount will apply to current CSA members.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. In particular, all competitors are directed to RRS 1.2, Life-Saving Equipment and Personal Flotation Devices, and RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority, Sponsors of the 2017 CLYC June JAM Regatta, and their employees and volunteers are not responsible for the loss of life or injury to participants or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel in any way or from any cause during or related to this event. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance sufficient to cover liability for damage, injury or death.

7 SCHEDULE OF RACES

Race packets will be available Friday, June 9, 5-8 PM.

Two or more races will be scheduled on Saturday, June 10. A required skippers meeting is scheduled for 8:45 AM on the deck east of the clubhouse; first warning is scheduled for 9:55 AM.

One race will be scheduled on Sunday, June 11. If no races are completed Saturday a second race may be scheduled. A required skippers meeting is scheduled for 9:00 AM on the deck east of the clubhouse; first warning is scheduled for 9:55 AM.

8 MEASUREMENT

A valid PHRF-LE certificate is preferred. Boats racing PHRF with One Design ratings shall comply with their One Design Class Rules. Boats without a PHRF-LE certificate may be inspected and will be assigned a rating based on PHRF-LE ratings plus 6 seconds per mile, plus any other adjustments the race committee, at their sole discretion, deems appropriate. All assigned ratings are valid for this regatta only and may not be protested. This changes RRS 60.1, 78.1, and 78.2.

Participants without PHRF-LE certificates are strongly encouraged to obtain one. Please refer to the PHRF-LE website at <http://www.phrf-le.org>.

A boat or her equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules, RRS, or the Sailing Instructions.

9 RACING AREA

Races will take place north of Chagrin Lagoons Yacht Club on Lake Erie. Scratch sheets, class assignments, and course locations will be distributed during the skipper's meetings.

10 SCORING

The low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will apply.

RRS Appendix A2 is changed. There will be no throw-out.

RRS Appendix A1 is changed to one race shall constitute a series.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded in the CLYC pavilion for first, second, and third place in each division following Sunday's finish.

12 GUEST DOCKAGE AND CHECK IN

Guest boats will be given complimentary guest dockage starting at noon on Wednesday, June 7, and after the event until noon on Wednesday June 14. Guest boats are requested to state their intended arrival and departure dates and times on the registration form, and to contact the CLYC gas dock on VHF channel 16 (working channel 71) or by phone at 440-942-0299 approximately 30 minutes before arrival. Upon arrival stop at the CLYC gas dock for dockage or rafting instructions. If arriving outside of gas dock business hours, (10:00 AM to 8:00 PM), please contact any of the co-chairs at the numbers given above.

Participants arriving by land may park in the designated guest area. Please note that parking in front of docks is reserved for dock holders only.

13 OTHER ACTIVITIES
